Ames Police Investigate Shooting

On June 1, 2026, at 10:43 p.m., the Ames Police Department responded to the 200 block of Franklin Avenue for a shooting. Officers located two adult males with gunshot wounds. The injuries to both parties are believed to be non-life threatening.

The Ames Police Department continues to investigate this incident. Based on our initial investigation, we do not believe there is an ongoing threat to the public.
