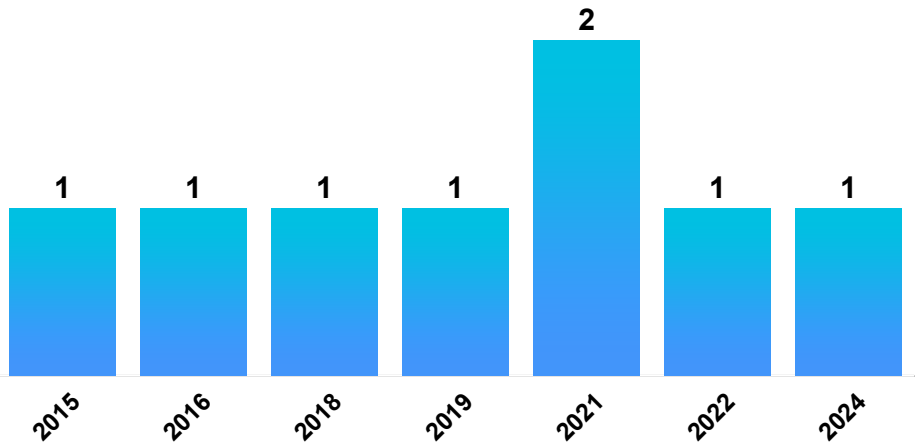

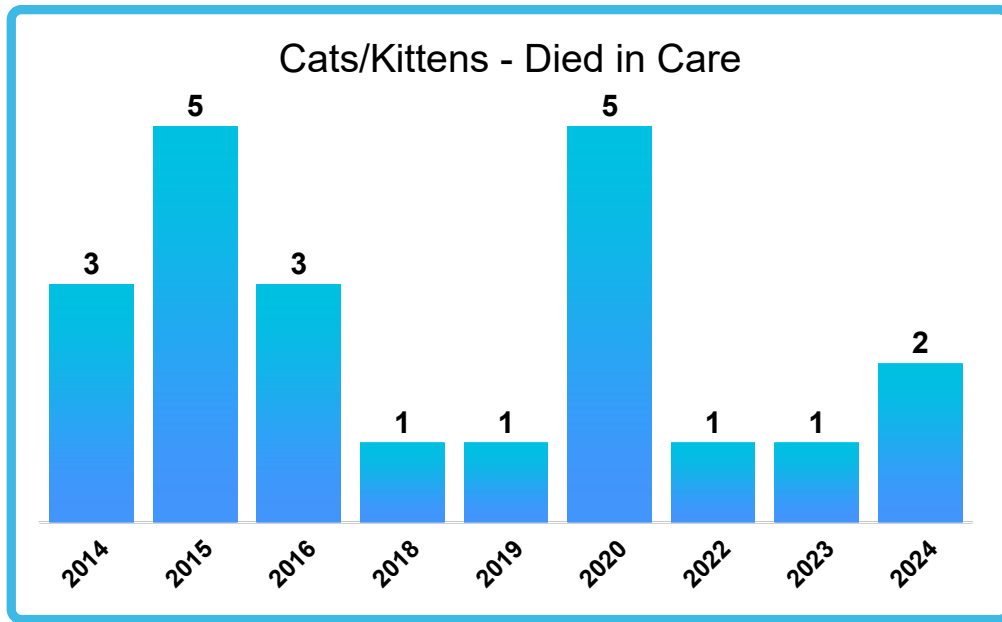


Cats/Kittens Transferred Out to Another Agency

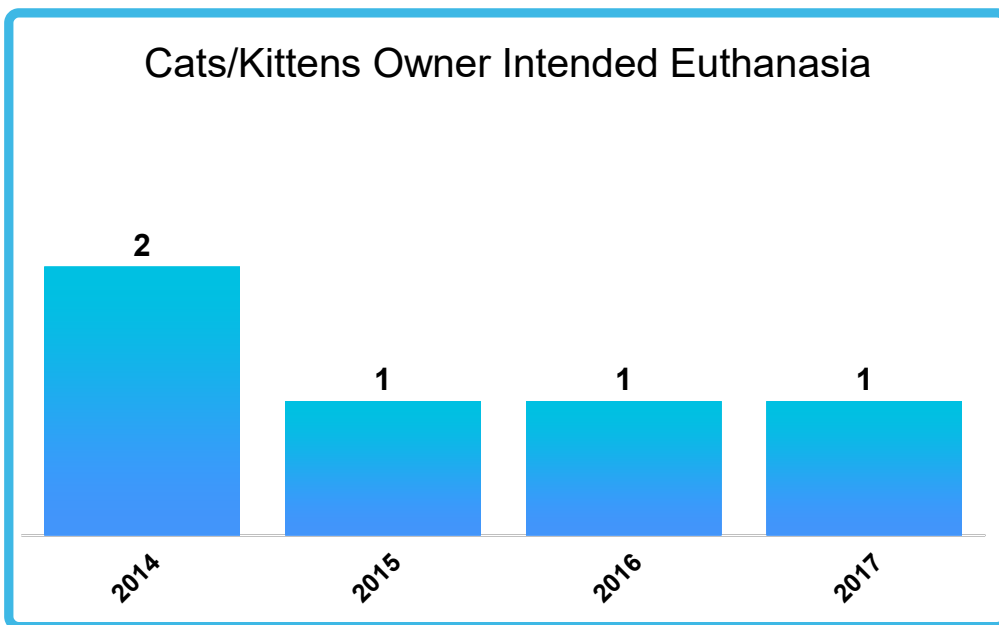
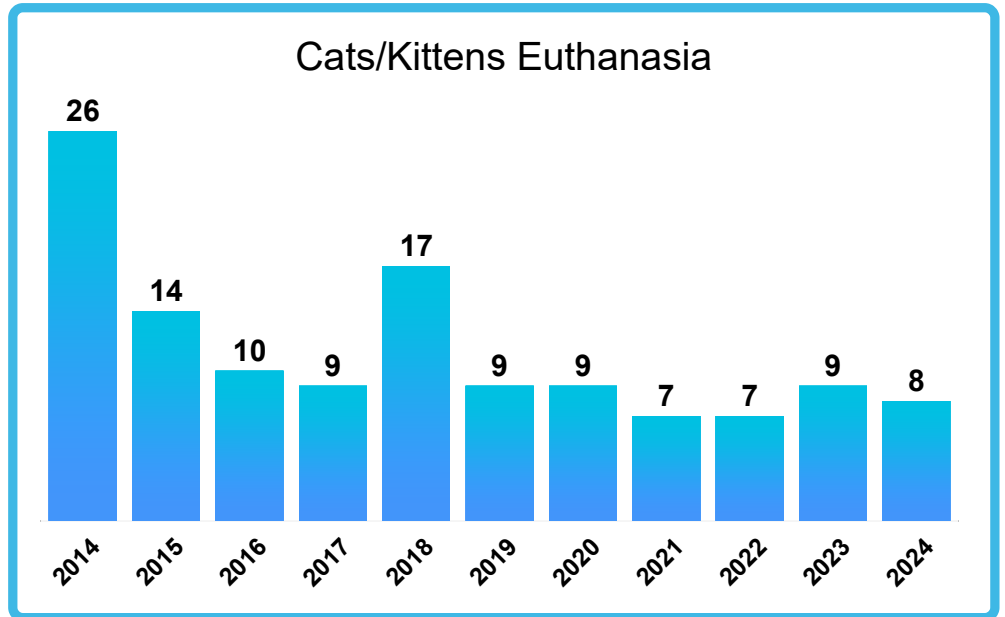
