Hyland Avenue to be reduced to single lane with alternating traffic.

Starting Date: Monday, April 20th.

For this year's construction, Hyland Avenue will remain open to through traffic. A temporary traffic signal will be used to control alternating northbound and southbound traffic in the southbound lane. This stage will extend from 1015 Hyland Avenue to the south side of Pammel Drive and will include pavement replacement and utility improvements.

Only the east side of the roadway will be reconstructed during this stage. Pammel Drive will be closed to all through traffic from Hyland Ave.

The existing sidewalk and the new section of the shared-use path will remain open during this stage. Cyclists are recommended to use the detour route via South Dakota Avenue.

Anticipated Duration: 6-7 weeks, weather dependent for this stage of the project.

Action Required by Residents: Expect delays with alternating traffic. Use alternate routes if available. Use caution, as lanes will be narrow and workers will be near lanes of traffic. Traffic may be stopped during paving operations.

Project Details: The City of Ames has contracted with All Star Concrete for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of Hyland Avenue. The project will include three stages of full PCC pavement replacement from Ontario Street to Pammel Drive, as well as patching and rehabilitation at select locations between Pammel Drive and Lincoln Way. As part of the project, the existing bike lanes on Hyland Avenue from Ontario Street to Oakland Street will be removed from the roadway and relocated to a new shared use path along the west side of Hyland Avenue. The following stage will see west side begin construction, shifting alternating signal-controlled traffic to the northbound lane of Hyland Avenue. This stage will extend from 1015 Hyland Avenue to the south side of Pammel Drive and will include pavement replacement, utility improvements, and continued construction of the shared-use path on the west side of Hyland Avenue. The shared-use path will be constructed up to Oakland Ave. The anticipated duration is 6-7 weeks, weather dependent.
