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Notice of Construction Hyland Ave Single Day Closure

Single day closure of Hyland Avenue from Ontario St. to Sheldon Ave. for grooving and final pavement markings.

Starting Date: Friday, August 7th.

Hyland Ave. will close to all through traffic on Friday August 7th, for pavement grooving and the placement of final pavement markings. This closure is scheduled to begin at **7:00 AM** and **is expected to reopen around 5:00 PM Friday.**

Grooving and painting operations will continue on Monday, August 10th, from Sheldon Ave. to Lincoln Way. Hyland Ave. will remain open Monday, but traffic may be flagged around painting operations.

With the completion of pavement markings, Hyland Ave. is planned to fully reopen to both lanes of traffic through the corridor by the end of the Monday, August 10th.

Anticipated Duration: Full closure- 7am to 5pm

Action Required by Residents:

Use alternate routes such as South Dakota Avenue or Grand Avenue for Friday's travel.

Hyland Avenue, from Ontario St. to Sheldon Ave., will be closed to all through traffic during the application of final paint markings.

Local residents with driveways will still have access. Use caution when entering the closure area and be aware of wet paint.

On Monday, expect delays as painting will continue through the rest of the Hyland ave corridor.

Project Details: The City of Ames has contracted with All Star Concrete for the reconstruction and rehabilitation of Hyland Avenue. The project will include three stages of full PCC pavement replacement from Ontario Street to Pammel Drive, as well as patching and rehabilitation at select locations between Pammel Drive and Lincoln Way. As part of the project, the existing bike lanes on Hyland Avenue from Ontario Street to Oakland Street will be removed from the roadway and relocated to a new shared use path along the west side of Hyland Avenue.
