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Informational Meeting on Ames Urban Fringe Plan Amendment is Aug. 10

AMES, Iowa - The City of Ames will hold an informational open house regarding a recent request by Friedrich Land Development to amend the Ames Urban Fringe Plan for the North Gap Area along George Washington Carver Avenue and south of Cameron School Road. The amendment would designate certain lands in this area as Urban Service Area, allowing for future annexation and development.

The open house will be at 7 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 10, in the Connect 2 room at Christ Community Church, 5501 George Washington Carver Ave. For your convenience, please park in the west parking lot and enter through the west door.

City staff will be available at the open house to describe the proposed Ames Urban Fringe Plan amendment, answer questions, and gather input regarding the proposal. Input gathered will be used in preparation for public hearings before the Planning and Zoning Commission and the City Council later this fall.
