## Welcome to the Dog Park

The dog park is an exciting outdoor fenced-facility for dog lovers and their dogs. The City of Ames offers an opportunity for dogs to play “off-leash” in a designated 10-acre dog park. The dog park is located at 605 Billy Sunday Road. Billy Sunday Road is located off South Duff Avenue, behind the City’s Animal Shelter.

The Dog Park is comprised of two areas; a 2-acre area for dogs less than 25 pounds and an 8-acre area for larger dogs.

To utilize the Dog Park owners must provide a current rabies vaccination certification and purchase a Facility Use Permit Tag.

**Please be sure to bring your dog’s current rabies vaccination certificate!**

## Facility Policies

To ensure the safety and well-being of all users:

- All dogs must have a current rabies vaccination certification.
- Each dog must have a valid Facility Use Permit Tag attached to their collar.
- The City of Ames Dog Park has **zero tolerance**



for improper disposal of dog waste! To decrease the spread of disease and to maintain a quality Dog Park, handlers must pick-up and dispose of their dog’s waste. A violation of this City ordinance

will result in a \$50 fine, plus \$50 in court fees and potentially the loss of your Facility Use Permit Tag.

- Some dogs exhibit unpredictable behavior around small children. For their safety, children age 9 & under are not allowed within the Dog Park.
- Children age 10 to 15 must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older).
- Dog handlers must be 16 years old or older.
- Maximum of two dogs per handler.
- The entire Dog Park, including the parking lot, is tobacco free.
- Alcohol is not allowed at this facility, including the parking lot.

For your dog’s safety:

- Dogs must be over four months old
- Dogs must be kept on a leash while entering and exiting the facility
- Dogs can never be left unattended
- Dogs should be in close range (within eyesight) of handler and under voice control at all times
- To maintain control, always carry a leash within the facility, one leash per dog
- Dogs exhibiting aggressive or unruly behavior will have their Facility Use Permit Tag revoked.
- Intact females may not attend park during their heat cycle.
- Human food is not allowed. Dogs may become aggressive around human food. Small training treats only are allowed!
- To protect dog paws, glass is not allowed at this site
- A flat buckle collar (with a Facility Permit Tag) is required. Pinch / prong / spike collars are not allowed. Playing with another dog wearing such a collar can injure other dogs.
- No digging, and owners are responsible and liable for any damage caused by their dogs.
- Sick dogs (i.e. Kennel Cough, etc.) should not be brought to the Dog Park.
