



Municipal Pool Reopening June 8 Swim Lesson Information

Swim lesson modifications have been implemented to allow for opportunities to resume swim lessons in a safe and responsible manner during COVID-19.

Modifications:

- In order to maintain social distancing while teaching close contact skills, Preschool and Levels 1, 2, 3A, and 3B will require an adult parent/guardian in the water with each participant.
 - The guardian must be at least 16 years old and comfortable in the water
 - No deep-water skills will be required for parent/guardian aided skill instruction
 - No additional spectators will be allowed into the facility
- Levels 4, 5, and 6 do not require a guardian in the water. One parent/guardian may bring the student into the facility and remain in the designated area; no additional spectators will be allowed.
- Social distancing should be maintained in all areas of the facility, both in and out of the water.
- All patrons and participants are encouraged to wear masks when not in the water.
- Participants are permitted into the facility no sooner than five minutes prior to their designated start time and required to leave the facility immediately after class ends.
- Please come dressed for class. Locker rooms will be available for restroom use only.
- Class times have been adjusted to allow for a 15-minute transition period between classes to allow for cleaning and disinfection, as needed, and to allow for one group to exit the facility before the next group arrives.
- All classes are at Municipal Pool and some classes are now on days different than originally scheduled.
- If you are sick, stay home.

Parking :

- Due to construction of the new high school, parking is different this year.
- Vehicles may access the new circle driveway from 20th Street. Vehicles may stop briefly for drop off and pick up but may not sit and wait or park any place other than designated parking spots (all violators will be towed).
 - There are four handicap accessible parking stalls near the pool and 20 general use parking spots along the circle drive.
 - Additional parking is available in the north “teacher’s” parking lot, at the end of 20th Street.
 - Street parking is available along 20th Street and Ridgewood Avenue.
- A bike rack is located near the pool entrance. Bike locks are encouraged.
- Overflow parking is at Furman Aquatic Center; the trail leading to Municipal Pool is open.
